Paul-Francois tells us all about what you can expect if you choose to register on this fascinating new module *A227 Exploring Religion*.

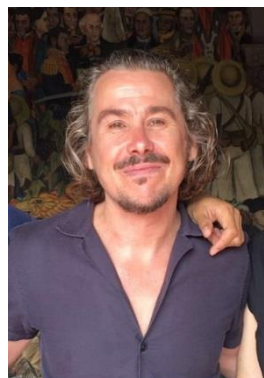

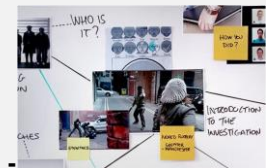
